Randwick Bloodstock's Fillies and Mares For Sale

Dear Melissa,

I will be attending the Keeneland & Fasig-Tipton Breeding Stock sales to be held in Kentucky in early November.

US bred mares make up a very small proportion of the Australian broodmare population however, when it comes to results you could say their produce have been over achieving on our racetracks.

In Australia and NZ over the past year, twenty-seven stakes winners have been produced from US bred mares. Just in the past month alone, US mares have produced the stakes winners RETRIEVE (current VRC Derby favourite), PRECEDENCE, SMART MISSILE, MORE STRAWBERRIES, LOVEMELIKEAROCK and YULALONA.

Over the past five years you're looking at a total of twenty-five Australasian Group 1 winners headed by the likes of MAKYBE DIVA, THESEO, MISS FINLAND, MALDIVIAN, NORTHERN METEOR, ALVERTA, SWISS ACE, etc, etc. From the small number of mares that Randwick Bloodstock has been involved with importing from the USA, these mares have produced the likes of HASNA (Champion Australian 2yo), DIATRIBE (VATC Caulfield Cup, STC Rosehill Guineas) and BLUE MURDER (SAJC SA Derby).

Each November, Kentucky hosts the world's biggest breeding stock sale. Conducted by the Keeneland Association, the sale normally totals in excess of 2,000 broodmares and broodmare prospects. This sale is ably supported by the US's other major auction house Fasig-Tipton, who at the same time conduct a small, but very select sale of quality breeding stock. Last year Australians were there in large numbers and they purchased some excellent stock which I have no doubt will in time produce many a good racehorse. In light of the decline of Australasian bloodstock values and returns in 2010, I expect this year could be a different story in respect of Australasian activity at these sales, even despite our dollar being strong against the US currency, plus US bloodstock values still remain well below levels from a few years ago.

If you are interested in procuring high quality bloodstock for a reasonable price, I encourage you to contact me to discuss what potentially is available at these two sales. Our fee is realistic and if given an order, we treat your money like it's our own money. We do lots of homework and leg work at the sales and if we cannot find the right horses to bid on, we won't spend your money. And should we find a suitable horse, we will recommend a figure to you that represents some value should the horse be able to be purchased through the auction process.
